

PRIVATE PARADISE

One Westwood home features expansive living spaces and a glorious finished basement.

Nestled within a canopy of trees by a pond, a 4,522-square-foot home rests—complete with swoonworthy amenities like a finished lower level, two recreation rooms and an at-home gym. The five-bed, four-full- and one-half-bath abode “is truly a well-designed home built with the highest of craftsmanship and quality, located in one of Westwood’s most desired locations,” says listing agent Elena Price. Designed with an open-concept floor plan, the entryway leads into a front sitting room and formal dining room, complete with a stunning crystal chandelier. Adjacent, a spacious kitchen and family room boast a built-in gas fireplace and views of the outdoor patio. The indulgent kitchen is accented with custom-built white cabinetry and an eye-catching quartzite island that doubles as a breakfast bar. Large

windows are present throughout the home, along with elegant crown molding, high ceilings and gleaming hardwood floors. Upstairs, find five carpet-lined bedrooms and sleekly designed bathrooms. Future homeowners are pampered with a soaking tub (perfect for late-night bubble baths) and a large, white-tiled glass shower. Ample natural light and stylish sconces that hover over the double vanity add finishing touches. After washing away the day, head to the primary bedroom featuring dramatic cathedral-vaulted ceilings, a fireplace and a walk-in closet.
